In many cases, I've just started playing with these things and since PHP 5.4 is still in BETA, I ran into a few problems. So yeah, expect silly examples and in some cases, no code examples at all. I haven't had the chance to use any of these new features in a production environment. When I do, I'm sure the examples will be more useful, well at least to me. Until then, either put up with my silly examples or – and here's a thought – install PHP 5.4 on your machine and start playing with it yourself. Add something into one of your existing projects and see if you can make proper use of it. The important thing to take away from this slide is:
